2015 Radio Station Inspection Program Status





- There were 1,016 inspections completed in 2014
- There have been 100 inspections completed so far this year.
- Inspections currently in progress for March 2015 are in New Mexico, Arizona and California.
- Goal for 2015 is 1000 stations.



Problems Found During Inspections





- Radios licensed, but not being used and need to be decommissioned.
- Additional radios found on frequencies that were not included on the station license.



Problems Found During Inspections



- Transmitters not marked with the licensed frequency.
- Customers are using frequencies that they are not licensed for.
- Unlicensed radios found that nobody knows who they belong to or if anyone is using them.






Summary of RSIP



- There were 1,016 inspections completed in 2014
- The areas that inspections were completed in 2014 were Colorado, Florida, Iowa, Minnesota, Nebraska, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia, and Washington
- There were 43 licensed radios that were not being used in 2014
